

Rules and regulations of the Fondation Tremplin Santé, for the *Health Challenge - Summer camps*.

Eligibility

1. This contest is open to all summer camps.
2. No purchase is necessary for this contest, which is intended for summer camps participating in the *Health Challenge – Summer camps*.
3. Summer camps must be registered for the *Health Challenge - Summer camps* and be engaged in a process to meet it between July 13 and 17, 2020.
4. Participation to the *Health Challenge - Summer camps* is free and cancellable at any time. However, to be declared winners, the summer camps drawn at random from all the summer camps registered in the *Health Challenge - Summer camps* will be asked a series of questions to determine if they have actually participated in the *Health Challenge - Summer camps* between July 13 and 17, 2020.

Registration

1. The Fondation Tremplin Santé competition, part of the *Health Challenge - Summer Camps* will take place from June 1, 2020 at 12:00 a.m. (EDT) to July 12, 2020 at 11:59 p.m. (EDT).
2. All the summer camps interested in participating in the Fondation Tremplin Santé contest, part of the *Health Challenge - Summer camps* must register between June 1, 2020 at 12:00 a.m. (EDT) and July 12, 2020 at 11.59 p.m. (EDT) by filling out the online form available at the tremplinsante.ca website.

Description of prizes

Three (3) prizes, three (3) winning summer camps.

- ✓ Prize offered by CATSPORTS

Sports and recreational equipment provided by CATSPORTS (\$250 x 1) value, issued as a gift card redeemable online at catsports.com will be provided to a summer camp that will have completed their registration between June 1, 2020 at 12:00 a.m. (EDT) and July 12, 2020 at 11:59 p.m. (EDT). Certain conditions may apply.

- ✓ Two prizes offered by the Fondation Tremplin Santé

Two gift cards from a local grocery store (each worth \$175), will be offered to two summer camps that will have completed their registration between June 1, 2020 at 12:00 a.m. (EDT) and July 12, 2020 at 11:59 p.m. (EDT). Certain conditions may apply.

Awarding of prizes and draw

- Capsana is the initiator of the *Health Challenge* and is the only entity responsible for the organization of draws, which will be conducted according to an extremely rigorous process under the supervision of a committee comprising internal representatives committed to the success of the *Health Challenge*. This committee is named the eligibility committee.
- Prizes must be accepted as they are described and awarded in the present Rules and regulations of the *Health Challenge*. They cannot be transferred or substituted with another prize, and are not exchangeable, in whole or in part, for a cash amount or another product. Capsana reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal value for another prize that cannot be awarded as outlined in the present Rules and regulations.
- The odds of winning depend on the number of entries received during the contest period.

The prizes will be awarded in the following way:

- Prizes will be drawn among all the participating Quebec summer camps duly registered and awarded in this order:
 - First winner drawn: prize offered by CATSPORTS
 - Second winner drawn: prize offered by the Fondation Tremplin Santé
 - Third winner drawn: prize offered by the Fondation Tremplin Santé
- The potential winning summer camps will be contacted by phone or e-mail as of July 17, 2020 and will have to answer a series of questions to determine whether they actually participated in the *Health Challenge*.

Commitment of the winning summer camps

1. The names of the winning summer camps will be posted on the healthchallenge.ca and tremplinsante.ca websites as well as on the social media accounts of both organizations.
2. A winning summer camp must consent, if required, and without compensation, to have their name, photograph of the group or of a representative, voice of a representative, city and region of operation, and/or all declarations related to winning the prize, used by the organizers of the *Health Challenge – summer camps* and its partners for communications and publicity purposes related to the *Health Challenge – summer camps*. The names of the students will not be divulged without a prior agreement (release form).

Authority and responsibilities

1. Capsana has FINAL AUTHORITY regarding rulings and decisions concerning the registration of participating summer camps and the evaluation of the eligibility of potential winners of the *Health Challenge – summer camps* contest, as well as the awarding of prizes.

Subject to the application of the Act respecting lotteries, publicity contests and amusement machines in relation to the present *Health Challenge – summer camps*, any dispute regarding the organization or conduct of a promotional contest may be submitted to the *Régie des alcools, des courses et des jeux du Québec* for a ruling. Any dispute regarding the awarding of a prize may be submitted to the *Régie des alcools, des courses et des jeux du Québec* only for the purpose of attempting to settle it.

3. Capsana, its employees and consultants as well as the organizers, partners and sponsors of the *Health Challenge – summer camps* CANNOT BE HELD LIABLE in the event of accident, loss or theft, or of any other problem or costs related, directly or indirectly, to the acquisition or use of a prize.
4. Taxes applicable under the Act respecting lotteries, publicity contests and amusement machines have been paid.
5. Refusal to accept a prize releases Capsana from any obligation related to that prize, including its delivery.
